ABOUT THE WEBINAR

Forensic accountants are traditionally associated with fraud investigation, conflict resolution, dispute analysis and expert testimony, and are not usually sought in valuing a business. However, business valuation is required for a variety of reasons and may well represent a step along the longwinded litigation process or the final deliverable in assisting the assessment of quantum.

This webinar will present an introduction and overview of business valuation methodologies in the context of forensic accounting based on a litigation practice paper published by The Law Society of Hong Kong in 2009. The International Valuation Standards (IVS), particularly IVS 200 and the previous directive GN 6, will also be discussed in respect of business valuation for commercial disputes and litigations.

He is a frequent speaker for the Hong Kong Institute of CPAs and was an examiner for the CPA Qualification Programme for seven years.

Miss Angela Chong is an analyst and investigative accountant specialising in research methodologies, financial modelling and data analytics, and has recently started to run field operations. Over the years, she has assisted Mr Kwok in a variety of civil and criminal cases, including shareholders' deadlock, contract dispute, estate contest, suspected embezzlement and conspiracy to defraud allegation.
